2014 Results...

An overview...

The 2014 budget had a planned deficit of \$98,312 (when excluding the planned use of \$20,000 of reserves for year 3 of the "Generations Campaign"). Session approved the use of reserves to cover the 2014 deficit as an investment in the future of First Pres and to provide uninterrupted support to our various ministries.

Key highlights are as follows:

- Actual expenses in 2014 exceeded actual income by \$95,834, slightly better than originally planned.
- Actual income of \$1,463,138 in 2014 was nearly \$19,000 below budgeted amounts.
- Expenses in 2014 of \$1,558,972 were approximately \$20,000 less than budgeted amounts.






2014 Results...

An overview... Our Gifts...



- Income continued to decrease in 2014 as compared to 2013. Total income (including transfers) in 2014 was \$1,463,138; down from \$1,537,400 in 2013 and \$1,565,900 in 2012.
- Over 87% of our general operating fund gifts resulted from congregational pledges, generally in line with the last 3 years; an additional 8% of our gifts come from non-pledge income the majority from our congregation. This is down from 11% in 2012.
- Pledge and non-pledge income, considered together, have remained relatively consistent 95% to 96% for 2010 through 2014.




These statistics do not begin to quantify the efforts and many hours our members contribute to the Church and our many Ministries!!




2014 Results (cont.)...

An overview... Use of Our Gifts...



- 65.1% of our expenses were used to fund personnel related costs in 2014. This represents a small decrease from prior years of 66.9% in 2013, and 67.4% in 2012.
- In 2014, Service and Outreach expended \$250,451, excluding Special Mission. This net amount represents 16% of our total expenses in 2014, in line with recent years.
- Service and Outreach, including Special Mission activity, represented 21% of our total expenditures in 2014.
- Buildings and Maintenance, Programs and Administrative costs remained relatively consistent over the three years in the aggregate.

Please contact the Finance and Stewardship committee with any questions.
- Total assets include an outstanding shared equity mortgage for former pastor Elisabeth Hartwell of \$55,000. In December 2014 First Pres was notified that the Hartwell's filed for bankruptcy. As a result, it is believed that most, if not all, of the remaining balance will ultimately be deemed uncollectable and an impairment and eventual write-off will likely need to be recognized when the full financial statements are prepared by an independent auditor.
- The summary fund information for Capital Campaign includes rental income and related expenses. Special giving
 amounts include unrestricted bequests and gifts.
